EXPANDING SCHOOL FOOD INFRASTRUCTURE IN CHRISTOPHER LAKE

The Saskatchewan Lions Foundation Inc. and Christopher Emma Lakeland Lions supported the Saskatchewan Rivers Public School Division's Christopher Lake School in providing more opportunities for students, staff, families, and volunteers to work together in the garden space and prepare good food.

The new equipment and garden boxes have enabled the school nutrition program to extend beyond growing and preparing food. Through hands-on learning, students have developed knowledge about healthy eating and where their food comes from.

Investment	\$20,000
Purchased	kitchen equipment, appliances, storage, indoor tower gardens, and garden boxes
Impact	more capacity to grow, prepare, and serve meals that foster hands-on learning, community connection, and long-term food security
Meals	prepared with fresh garden produce
Participation	now serving 160 students
Partnerships	the gardens have strengthened community relationships and created a shared sense of purpose
