EXPANDING SCHOOL FOOD INFRASTRUCTURE IN FORT QU'APPELLE

Fort Qu'Appelle Community Outreach Management Corp. has partnered with local schools for years through a collaboration with Prairie Valley School Division to provide produce, proteins, and healthy snacks that are regularly distributed for the school food programs in the area.

The purchase of commercial-grade equipment has enabled safer processing and distribution of locally sourced food, including wild game and produce, incorporating more Indigenous and meaningful foods into school meals.
