EXPANDING SCHOOL FOOD INFRASTRUCTURE IN NIPAWIN

Nipawin Nutrition for Kids works to increase awareness of child hunger, provide food to hungry children, and encourage healthy nutrition for families by running breakfast programs from two elementary schools in the North East School Division.

New appliances and kitchen equipment have transformed the breakfast program into a more sustainable and efficient food service model. Demand for the breakfast program has steadily grown and has fostered a greater sense of shared responsibility within the school community.

Investment

\$28,000

Purchased

new stoves, a commercial grade refrigerator, freezer units, dry storage systems, food storage containers, and small kitchen appliances

Impact

students can consistently access balanced meals in a welcoming environment that promotes dignity and belonging

expanded menu options to include culturally responsive and balanced meals
