# **2022 Mosaic School Nutrition Challenge Open to Applications**

The Mosaic School Nutrition Challenge encourages grassroots initiatives to promote student nutrition and healthier school environments through nutritionrelated activities and programming. Cash awards of \$10,000 each will be awarded to 10 successful applicants.

Participants are invited to submit applications that explain their current school environment and improvement plans for the upcoming school year.

New programs and projects or enhancements to successful existing programs are considered eligible.




# **Trustee Academy Highlights**
