Create a Working Advisory Group (WAG) to review the existing statement and develop options for changes to the Position Statement.</p>	<p>A. Advocacy ongoing and will ramp up closer to election.</p> <p>B. Budget Day didn't go as expected with only a spending plan released on March 18, 2020 due to COVID-19. A small increase to funding education was in the spending – but continued pressures are felt by our members given it still does not restore fully the cuts and address inflationary pressures. Given the global pandemic and economic uncertainty, school boards did share a message of appreciation for stability of funding at this unprecedented time.</p> <p>C. Committee members have been appointed. Chair to call first meeting. Due to various factors and competing priorities, it is not expected that this position statement will be drafted in time for the feedback processes/timelines required for adoption at Fall Assembly 2020. Committee work will continue this year, in preparation for adoption in 2021.</p>
